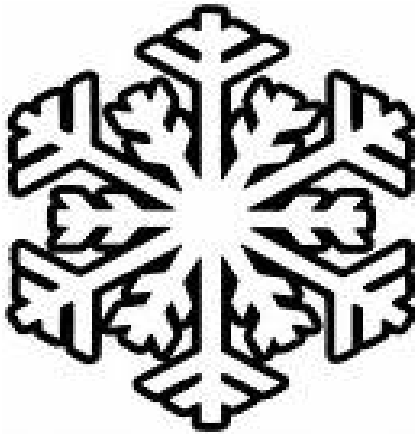

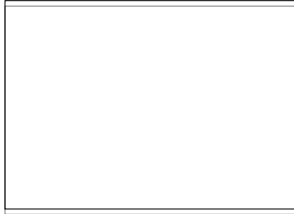
COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES
