



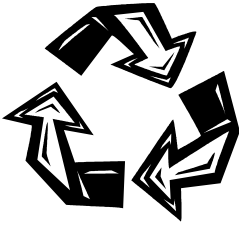

### **SPRING GARDEN CLUB EVENT**

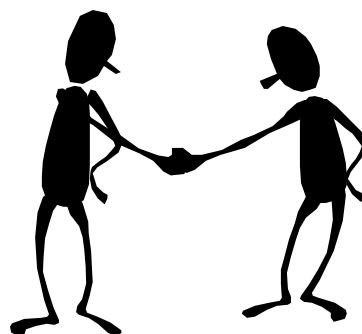

## **PCR PICK-UP & DROP-OFF POLICY**

PCR has a detailed pick-up and drop-off policy in order to keep all of our members safe. This policy states that **all members should be brought into the program area by their parent/guardian/counselor**. This allows the parent/guardian/counselor to confirm that the program is being held, as well as facilitating communication between the parent/guardian/counselor and the program instructor and PCR staff. In addition, any registration problems will be dealt with at this time. Please do not drop off members to any program before the stated start time, as there may be other programs running or PCR staff may be preparing the program space for the program.

**Parents, guardians, and counselors should also enter the program area to pick up their members.** PCR staff will not allow any PCR member to leave the program area if he or she is not accompanied by a parent, guardian, or counselor. If your PCR member plans to travel independently, you should notify Seth Duncan, PCR Program Coordinator, in writing at [seth@pcr-inc.org](mailto:seth@pcr-inc.org) or make note of it on the program registration form. Once again, this policy is designed to keep PCR members safe, but also to help facilitate communication between parents, guardians, and counselors and the program instructors and PCR staff.

Please also remember that PCR has a strict late pick-up policy. The policy states that parents, guardians, or agency will be charged **\$10 for every 15 minutes, or part thereof**, that they are late picking up a PCR member. Payment must be mailed to the PCR office before the member may return to any PCR program. If you are unsure about the end time for a particular program, please check with the PCR program staff when you drop your member off at program.

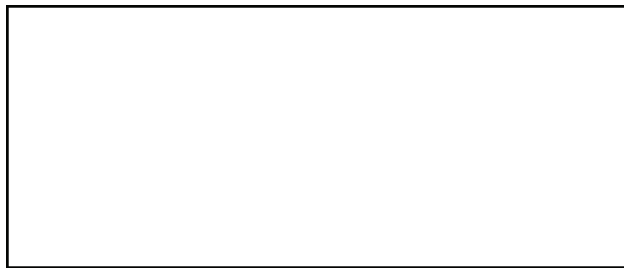
