## From Joe Feakes, Development Director

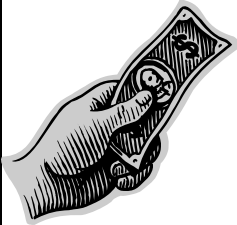

JSSA is currently inviting applications from adults with disabilities for Rolling Access funding.

Rolling Access funds, which are provided by the Developmental Disabilities Administration of Southern Maryland, are one-time-only funds. They are available to adults with disabilities who do not already receive DDA funding.

Rolling Access funds may be used to help pay for purchases or services that are directly connected to the individual's disability, e.g., they may be used to help pay for group therapy, medical expenses, personal care, or an item of assistive technology; they may not be used to pay for rental.

Rolling Access funds must be disbursed before June 30, 2007. This means that applicants must be prepared to complete paperwork etc. in a timely fashion!

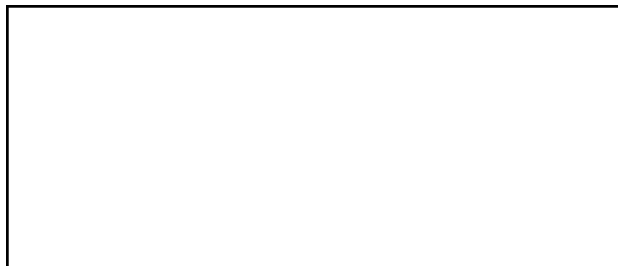
